Marcine Beck, 83, of Mount Pleasant, South Carolina, entered into eternal rest late Monday, February 11, 2019. A memorial service will be held Friday, March 1, 2019, at 11:30 am, in the chapel of Charleston Cremation Center Funeral Home, 2054 Wambaw Creek Rd., Charleston, SC 29492.

Marcine was born May 19, 1935, in Charleston, West Virginia. She attended college at Marshall University, soon leaving to go to Washington, D.C., to work as a secretary for the Central Intelligence Agency. After meeting her husband, also with the C.I.A., and having children, her devotion turned to her family. While in Berwyn, PA, and Vienna, VA, Marcine was active in schools and community, volunteering countless hours organizing events from school fundraisers to team parties, and soon graduating to organizing political fundraisers and campaigns for candidates running for the VA House of Representatives and Governor. She owned "The Craft Studio" in Vienna, VA, for 5 years, where she was known for her talent in making (Faberge) eggs and her skilled brush with painting. After retiring to Lake Wylie, SC, she continued her legacy of artistic talents while enjoying league bowling, playing bridge and leading an active social life. Marcine also loved playing the piano, quilting, reading, and traveling. She loved her grandchildren most of all.

Marcine was predeceased in death by her husband, Charles (Chuck) Beck, Jr., and her son, Steven Beck, her parents, Everett and Inez Trent, and her twin sister, Racine Foote. She is survived by her daughter, Shari Sebuck (Jeff), of Mount Pleasant, SC, grandsons Dylan and Cameron Sebuck, of Mount Pleasant, SC, granddaughter, Devyn Beck, of Charlotte, NC, sister, Josephine Kiefer (Bob), of Lexington, KY, and brother Roy Trent (Nancy), of Oakton, VA., and a host of Nephews, Nieces, and Cousins.
